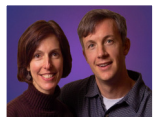


Ole & Carole Olson

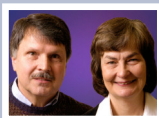


Mark & Jackie Evans

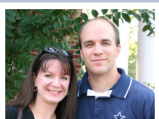


Dennis & Anne Van Curen
